II. Section 4.0, Page 14

Add new sentence to end of first paragraph to read as follows:

“The third phase of questions will be accepted until close of business on April 27, 2017. Written answers to the third phase of questions will be posted to the ACTA website by close of business May 3, 2017.”

III. Section 4.0 Page 14, second paragraph, first sentence

The expected date of the interview is changed from May 17, 2017 to May 31, 2017.

IV. Section 5.0, Page 15

Add new second sentence to read as follows:

“Tables, charts and graphics may be single spaced with smaller font, but must be easy to read.”

V. Appendix A Maintenance Agreement

Article 1 page 4, replace “April 15, 2017” with “on or about September 1, 2017”.

VI. Appendix Q Cost Proposal Forms

Section I, Footnote 1, delete and substitute:

“All quoted hourly rates are to be fully burdened, including but not limited to: salary paid to employee; overhead markups including fringe benefits, etc.; profit; local administrative support; and personal safety equipment for contractor and subcontractor. If position is through a subcontractor so indicate.”
